39 countries need SAFE interventions to eliminate Trachoma*

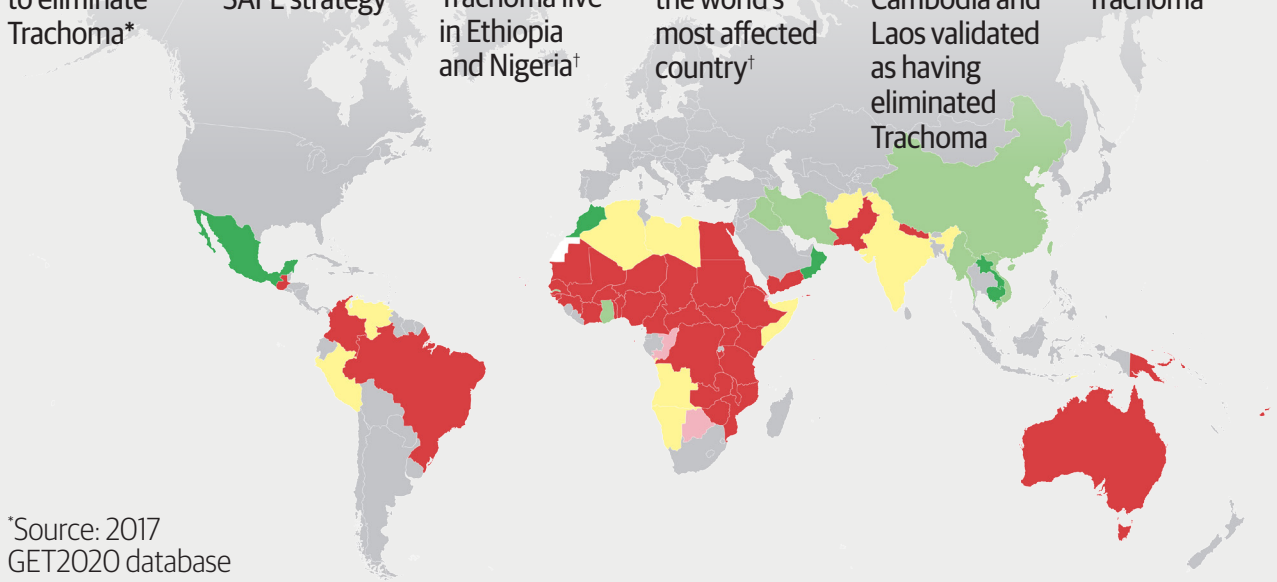
34 countries actively implementing SAFE strategy*

Over 50% of the people at risk of Trachoma live in Ethiopia and Nigeria†

75 million people at risk in Ethiopia, the world's most affected country†

5 countries Oman, Mexico, Morocco, Cambodia and Laos validated as having eliminated Trachoma

6 countries claim to have eliminated Trachoma

According to the Global Health Observatory, 2016

- Known to require interventions to eliminate Trachoma
- Claims to have eliminated Trachoma
- Thought to not require interventions
- Status uncertain
- Validated as having eliminated Trachoma

It is estimated that **US\$1 billion** is needed to eliminate Trachoma entirely

The target is to eliminate Trachoma completely **by 2020**
